## **CONSTITUTION**

### **PREAMBLE**

### **ARTICLE 1**

#### **Clash of Minds:**

- The participants can submit a creative piece, or an essay related to the theme.
- The participants are given the liberty to write based on their understanding of the theme.
- The word limit of the submission is 400–500 words and it must strictly be hand written.
- If any form of plagiarism is found in your work, it will be disqualified.
- The submissions should reach the board members between 12<sup>th</sup> August to 14<sup>th</sup> August 2018
- If the participant cannot submit the physical copy on time, she is asked to scan the handwritten physical copy and send it to the Mail ID: [rotaractclubofstellamaris@gmail.com](mailto:rotaractclubofstellamaris@gmail.com)

### **ARTICLE 2**

#### **Sketch-It:**

- The participants can either paint or doodle based on the theme.
- The participants are asked to use A4 or A3 sheet.
- If any form of plagiarism is found in your work, it will be disqualified.
- The submissions should reach the board members between 12<sup>th</sup> August to 14<sup>th</sup> August 2018
- The participants are asked to submit the physical copy on time.

### **ARTICLE 3**

#### **Verse Versus Verse:**

- The participants can compose either lyrical or classical poetry.
- The composition must be 15-25 lines and must be handwritten.
- If any form of plagiarism is found in your work, it will be disqualified.
- The submissions should reach the board members between 12th August to 14<sup>th</sup> August 2018
- If the participant cannot submit the physical copy on time, she is asked to Scan the handwritten physical copy and send it to the Mail ID: rotaractclubofstellamaris@gmail.com

### **ARTICLE 4**

#### **Fill the Billboard:**

- The participants can either do a physical poster or an online poster.
- The participants are asked to do the physical poster in a chart paper.
- If any form of plagiarism is found in your work, it will be disqualified.
- The submissions should reach the board members between 12th August to 14th August 2018
